



CODE OF CONDUCT

For all members & visitors where applicable

Norwood Park Golf Centre actively encourages good standards of conduct from all our Members, Visitors and Staff. We operate within guidelines issued by golf's governing bodies.

Members are expected to show respect to others, including members & staff of NPGC and the wider golfing community. Members are also expected to give due respect to the reputation and good name of NPGC, including interaction on all aspects of Social Media, examples of expected standards are included, but not limited to, below:

- The Rules of Golf and Etiquette must be adhered to at all times both on and off the course
- The Dress Code applicable to all areas of the Golf Centre must be adhered to at all times
- Bullying and/or discrimination will not be tolerated
- Differences in gender, disability, culture, race, ethnicity, age, sexual orientation and religious beliefs should be respected
- Inappropriate language: please refrain from using any language that may cause offence, especially as the Centre actively encourages juniors
- Junior members and Junior visitors should also refer to our Code of Conduct and Child Protection Policy for the safeguarding of children in golf.

- All our staff deserve the right to work in a safe environment this also includes Social Media.

As part of our commitment to golf development we aim to provide a safe and friendly environment which also includes all aspects of Social Media - referring to all social networking sites such as (but not limited to) Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Google+, YouTube and includes email and mobile devices

All reports of cyber bullying and other technology misuses will be investigated fully and may result in notification to the police

Anyone found behaving in a threatening or inappropriate manner in breach of the Code may be asked to leave the premises and further action may be taken, Sanctions may include, but are not limited to, suspension, or termination from membership of NPGC
